

Invitation to submit an application for funding to be announced

It is anticipated that during the month of January the Public Health Agency of Canada will be distributing an invitation to organizations to submit an application for funding. This funding represents the 2010-12 portion of the \$10M investment into respiratory health activities announced by Health Minister Leona Aglukkaq in April, 2009.

Focus Areas

This solicitation will focus on the implementation of tools and interventions that work towards the prevention and management of respiratory disease. Target areas include chronic and infectious disease, as well as indoor and outdoor environmental risk factors.

Deadline and Submission Guidelines

When the invitation has been distributed, it will include a deadline for applications, and will be accompanied with detailed guidelines for submission (including the maximum amount of funds that will be available for each project, and the start and end date of each project). It is anticipated that the deadline for submission will be in early April, and that projects will not begin before August 1, 2010. Funding will be in the form of contributions with the possibility of multi-year funding until March 31, 2012.

When the invitation has been released by the Public Health Agency of Canada, it will be widely promoted by the National Lung Health Framework Partnership Secretariat through the Framework Listserv, and on the Framework Website <http://lunghealthframework.ca>
