Continuing education / professional development activities (1 hour = 1 credit)

- Attend a lecture, conference, focus group, workshop, forum or seminar
- Take a recognized course or certification (e.g. ACLS, BLS, CPR)
- Participate in a webinar

Workplace activities (1 hour = 1 credit)

- Attend employer continuing education events, grand rounds or inservices
- Develop or revise policies and procedures

Professional volunteer activities (4 hours = 1 credit)

- Volunteer on CSRT committees and workgroups
- Volunteer at provincial association or regulatory body
- Volunteer at CBRC exam activities
- Volunteer for the CJRT or other CSRT initiative
- Promote or advocate for the profession
- Perform other RT-related committee work

Reflective activities (1 hour = 1 credit)

- Read a professional journal article
- Complete directed reading activity
- Complete profession-related surveys

Advanced continuing education /professional development activities (1 hour = 2 credits)

- Perform clinical or basic science research
- Present at a local, provincial or national conference, or at a local work-related event
- Publish in a peer-reviewed journal
- Complete a university and/or college course in a health care topic

Preceptorship (8 hours = 1 credit)

• Preceptorship hours are defined as contact hours spent in the clinical setting with students, and/or members of other health disciplines.
