Online elections – CSRT Board of Directors

CSRT members are invited to select members for the Board of Directors for the perspective from the following areas of practice: education and from industry. The on-line election process will be held between February 1 and February 19, 2016. No election is required for the regional perspective at this time (Québec and non-regulated jurisdictions) as the selection of the areas of practice have priority over regional perspective. Should the elected Board members also meet the regional requirements, no further election is required. The Board members elected by the members will then be ratified at the Annual General Meeting to be held in Ottawa on Friday, May 27th – their term will be from May 2016 to May 2018. National Competency Framework Validation Survey a success!

We are very proud of all RTs who participated in the validation survey for the national competency framework. There were a total of 2875 respondents to the validation survey, over 25% of the addressed population of RTs, of which 1674 (almost 15%) surveys were complete. This is considered a remarkable result by the consultants hired for this project, especially in view of the length and complexity of the survey. This has been achieved in a large measure by the passion of RTs for their profession.

The CSRT will provide 3 CPD credits to all its members who completed the survey. We also drew a name for a complimentary registration to the 2016 CSRT conference which will be held in Ottawa from May 26 to May 28, 2016 – the winner is *Lily Cheung from British Columbia*.

The CSRT continues to work with the regulators for the next step in the development of the national competency framework which is the analysis of the results and the development of the exam matrix which should be completed by this spring. We will keep you posted on our progress.
