

January 1, 2019: Deadline to Apply for CCAA Under Grandfathering Clause

Until January 1, 2019 the CSRT will offer the Certified Clinical Anesthesia Assistant certificate and CCAA professional designation to recognize AAs who have already completed an education program and/or achieved competencies through clinical experience and can provide an attestation from their immediate supervisor that they have achieved the competencies outlined in the 2016 National AA
